Mavutani Protection Services is one the leading security company here in South Africa to offer electronic Guard monitoring technology.

A tag that records the guard's presence and movement at all Time during their shift as requested by the client monitors each guard and premises we guard. The guard is supposed to patrol the client's premises every 30 minutes and movements are recorded by transmitters installed at random locations throughout the premises.

The information can be availed to client on daily weekly or monthly basis to prove service delivery. Inspectors and Supervisors have mobile tag equipment that records the presence of the guards at their locations.

The guards are also equipped with a panic button that they can activate when the premises attacked. Our Armed Response Unit is guaranteed to arrive at response area within 10 minute under normal circumstances.

### **PHYSICAL SECURITY MAN GUARDING**

Our security officers are trained and vetted by professional trainers who have international and local experience. All of our security guards are PSIRA registered. In addition we also provide our security officers with in- house and on-site training.



## **GUARD PATROL SURVEILLANCE**

A sufficient number of Guards in uniform and or plain clothes can be deployed on request in the wake of unique or special situations whereby large crowds of people are expected at a given point due to a wedding or funeral ceremony etc., thereby necessitating the taking of precautionary measures to ensure safety of people & property on the ground.

#### Professional Experience

- **Guard Force Commander, EOD Technology, Inc., South Africa, 10/09-Present.** Ensure that all Guards, Supervisors, and Mobile Patrol personnel report to their posts on a timely basis, and that all Senior Guards and Supervisors have carried out their responsibilities. Question the Shift Supervisor of the previous shift and review the logbooks, noting any unusual occurrences or incidents that may have taken place. Immediately inform the RSO/FSNI, or designated official, of any event or information that could affect the safety or security of U.S. Consulate General facilities in Johannesburg, South Africa. Visit all official facilities a minimum of two times each day in order to verify that the post is manned and the guard is alert and performing his/her specific duties; verify that the Guard is in correct uniform; and verify the correct operation of the radio, flashlight, and any gates or physical barriers. During the evening inspections, verify that all exterior lights are working properly. Serve as information link between the RSO/FSNI and Guard Force, passing information and instructions to the Shift Supervisors, verifying understanding and assuring proper performance. Report all deficiencies to the RSO/FSNI and take action to have the deficiencies corrected. Maintain a log of activities, recording the names of Guards inspected, and noting deficiencies, inoperative equipment, security problems, and other significant problems.
- **Supervisor, G4S, 5 years.** Complied with all General Orders. Maintained familiarity with all aspects of the operational guard program, including the General Orders and Post Orders, as well as knowledge of the unique characteristics of each individual post. Ensured that all Guards and Mobile Patrol personnel reported to their posts on time, and that all Senior Guards carried out their responsibilities. Served as a direct link between the guard shift and the Guard Force Commander, RSO/FSNI. Reported any unusual occurrence or incident to one or more of these officers. Checked guards, as well as Senior Guards, to ensure that there were no problems requiring resolution and that all Guard personnel were performing their assigned tasks.
- **Security Officer, United International Investigate, 4 years.**
- **Site Manager, Premier Loss, 4 years and 4 months.**
- **Site Supervisor, Conway Security, 4 years.** Responsibilities included booking Security Officers on duty. Ensured that the Security Officers performed their duties as expected of them. Ensured that posts were safe and secure. Communicated using two-way radios and telephones. Liased with Patrolling Supervisors, directing them to perform specific duties, such as driving by areas to check the situation. Compiled weekly reports.

## THE GUARD FORCE COMMANDER

### FUNCTION:

As the Senior Operational Officer, provides overall supervision and control of all Guards and Supervisors assigned during the shift. The Guard Force Commander serves as the direct point of contact for all Guard Force issues.

### SPECIFIC DUTIES:


The following instructions will be observed by the Guard Force Commander.

- a. The Guard Force Commander must be familiar with all aspects of the operational Guard program; to include the General Orders and the Post Orders, as well as knowledge of the characteristics of each post.
  - b. The Guard Force Commander will insure that all Guards, Supervisors and patrols report to their post on a timely basis and that all Senior Guards and Supervisors have carried out their responsibilities.
  - c. The Guard Force Commander will question the Shift Supervisor of the previous shift and review logbooks as to any unusual occurrences or incidents, which may have taken place.
  - d. The Guard Force Commander will immediately inform the Project Manager, RSO/ARSO, PSO and/or MSG at Post One of any event or information, which could affect the safety, or security of the U.S. Mission and its facilities in South Africa.
  - e. The Guard Force Commander will randomly check guards as well as other Supervisors to insure that there are no problems requiring resolution and that all Guard personnel are performing their assigned tasks.
- Visit all official facilities posts a minimum of once every four days and accomplish the following:
    1. Verify if the post is manned and if the guard is alert and performing his/her duties as specified in the orders. If possible, the Guard Force Commander should conduct one joint round per visit to a post with the Guard assigned to conduct the round.
    2. Verify the Guard is in the correct uniform;
    3. Verify the correct operation of the radio, flashlight, and any gates or physical barriers. During night time inspection, verify that the exterior lights are functioning properly.

4. Serve as information link between the RSO/ARSO/PSO and the Guard Force. Pass information and instructions to the Shift Supervisors, verify understanding and assure performance.
  5. Report all deficiencies to the RSO/ARSO/PSO and take action to have the deficiencies corrected.
- Maintain a log of your activities, record the names of Guards inspected, deficiencies noted, inoperative equipment, security problems, and any significant activities during your tour of duty.
  - f. The Guard Force Commander will maintain radio contact with the Mobile Patrols, Senior Guards and the Supervisors at the various installations.

The Guard Force Commander will ensure that a radio check is conducted from each Guard post to the shift supervisor a minimum of every sixty minutes. These checks are to be conducted at the beginning of each shift (within the first fifteen minutes) to ensure that all Guards have reported for duty.

- g. The Guard Force Commander will insure that Incident Reports are properly written and disseminated and insure that any reports required to be submitted to the RSO's or PSO's office are accomplished on a timely basis.
- h. When required, the Guard Force Commander will screen any suspect letters and packages using the x-ray machine and Itemizer. They will notify the RSO/ARSO /PSO/MSG if anything suspicious is detected.
- i. The Guard Force Commander will report all infractions of the General or Post Orders to his Local Guard Force Coordinator and through him to the RSO/ARSO/PSO.
- j. Guard Force Commander is to attend meetings with Local Guard Force Commander at least once a week as necessary to go over reports and receive instructions or as directed by the RSO/ARSO/PSO.
- k. Guard Force Commander should conduct contract administrative matters and not delegate to other guards unless requested by RSO/ARSO/PSO.
- l. Guard Force Commander should conduct briefings of each relief guard immediately at the beginning of the shift.
- m. In the absence of the Project Manager, the Guard Force Commander will be the point of contact for logistical issues.
